- 5b with all your heart and with all your soul, בְּכָל-לִבְבְּךָ וּבְכָל-נַפְשְׁךָ
- 5c and with all your might וּבְכָל-מְאֹדְךָ:
- 6a. And these words, וְהָיוּ הַדְּבָרִים הָאֵלֶּה
