

## BABYSITTING INFORMATION – 2019

There will be **NO** Young Family Service or Youth Service the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Rosh Hashanah (10/1). Complimentary babysitting for children 18 months and above will be provided in the school wing from 10:00am - 1:00pm on both days of Rosh Hashanah and on Yom Kippur.

Space permitting, we will have a room in the Nursery School level open from 9:30am-1:00p both days of Rosh Hashanah and on Yom Kippur for any parents and children who need a "break from adult services". The Sanctuary Service is not piped into the Nursery School room.

It is important that our children, and everyone attending services, are given a safe environment in which to share their holiday experience. We ask that you make yourself available in case your child needs you during services. Remember, though childcare and children's services are available, ***children are ultimately the responsibility of their parents.***

Childcare babysitters will have a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy for unruly, disrespectful and overly disruptive children, and will not be responsible for attending to them. Children who are unable to handle the childcare environment will be brought to their parents for supervision for the rest of the service. Remember, care of your child is your responsibility. Our goal is to make the service and youth programs meaningful, safe and welcoming for EVERYONE.

Please make sure you and your children leave both of these areas in the same condition that you found them. Please be especially careful of the toys and books in lower level rooms - they belong to the Nursery School and must remain in the room at all times. Due to dietary restrictions and food allergies, outside food will not be allowed in babysitting, except for children with special dietary requirements. **Please do not bring any food containing nuts.**
