הָאָרֶץ,
• וּבַיּוֹם הַשְּׁבִיעִי, שָׁבַת וַיִּנְפֹּשׁ.

You sing alone:

עַל כֵּן בֵּרַךְ ה' אֶת יוֹם הַשַּׁבָּת וַיְקַדְּשֶׁהוּ.

סִבְרֵי חֲבֵרֵי:

(The congregation responds: "לְחַיִּים!")

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה', אֱ-לֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, בּוֹרֵא
פְּרֵי הַגֶּפֶן.
