Taking Out the Torah (Saturday Morning)

Hold Torah over your right shoulder.
Face the congregation.
First you chant, then congregation repeats:

First you chant, then congregation repeats:

אֶחָד אֶ-לֵהֵינוּ, גָּדוֹל אֲדוֹנֵנוּ, קְדוֹשׁ שְׁמוֹ.

Face ark and bow for Gadlu, stand up for Un'rom'ma

גָּדְלוּ לַה' אֱתֵי, וַיְרֹמְמָה שְׁמוֹ יַחְדָּו.

Walk down the stairs and down the middle aisle, and then take a right, letting everyone kiss the Torah. Continue past your family and then go up the stairs and give the Torah to a Gabbai.
