

V'ahavta וְאַהֲבַתָּהּ

5a. You shall love Adonai your God וְאַהֲבַתָּהּ אֶת ה' אֱ-לֹהֶיךָ

5b with all your heart and with all your soul, בְּכָל-לִבְבְּךָ וּבְכָל-נַפְשְׁךָ

5c and with all your might :וּבְכָל-מְאֹדְךָ

6a. And these words, וְהָיוּ הַדְּבָרִים הָאֵלֶּה

6b which I command you this day, אֲשֶׁר אֲנֹכִי מְצַוְךָ הַיּוֹם

6c you shall take to heart :עַל-לִבְבְּךָ

7a. Teach them to your children, וְשִׁנַּנְתָּם לְבָנֶיךָ

7b and speak of them (or “recite them”) וְדַבַּרְתָּ בָם

7c when you return home בְּשִׁבְתְּךָ בְּבֵיתְךָ

7d and when you go on your way, וּבְלַכְתְּךָ בַדֶּרֶךְ

7e when you lie down and when you get up. :וּבְשָׁכְבְּךָ וּבְקוּמְךָ

8a. Bind them as a sign upon your hand, וְקָשַׁרְתָּם לְאוֹת עַל-יָדְךָ

8b and as a reminder between your eyes. :וְהָיוּ לְטַטְפֹּת בֵּין עֵינֶיךָ

9a. Inscribe them on the doorposts of your homes וְכָתַבְתָּם עַל-מַזְזוֹת בְּיַתְדְךָ

9b and upon your gates :וּבְשַׁעְרֶיךָ
