

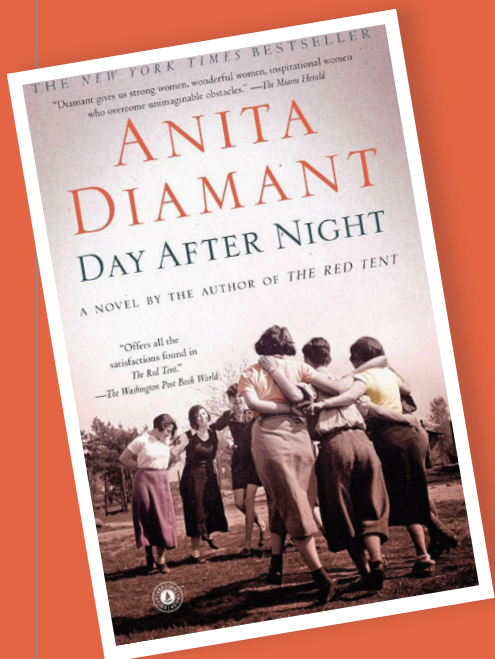
ONE SHUL—ONE BOOK

Sisterhood Shabbat is excited to host bestselling author, ANITA DIAMANT at Temple Israel of Natick.



Anita Diamant will discuss *DAY AFTER NIGHT*, a book about a little-known aspect of Israel's history. It tells the story of four young women who escaped the Holocaust and arrived on Palestine's shores before Israel became a state in 1948. The women are interned when they arrive, locked up behind barbed wire fences in Atlit, a prison camp run by the British, who ruled Palestine at the time. There they befriend one another as they grapple with a new life in a new land. "Although the history is compelling, the real interest lies in the way Diamant shows these women learning to go on—forming new bonds, rediscovering simple daily pleasures, coming to terms with the past." —Booklist
