Dear Friends,

During this challenging time, we all can use a little more love. In that spirit, I wanted to apprise you of a wonderful opportunity to cultivate more love through the practice of mindful Jewish prayer, with a wonderful founding teacher of the Institute for Jewish Spirituality, Rabbi Sheila Peltz Weinberg. Sheila, one of my mentors, and the teacher who first introduced me to Jewish Mindfulness practice, was scheduled to be a Shabbat Scholar in Residence at TI this month. Unfortunately, the pandemic forced us to cancel that event.

However, beginning May 3, Sheila will be offering a self-paced 4-week online intensive through the Institute for Jewish Spirituality Prayer Project: *Receiving and Extending Love: Jewish Prayer Through Meditation*. In this mini-course, Sheila uses the *Shema* and its proximate blessings to teach three concrete meditation practices that help us to feel held by an unending stream of divine love and then extend that love more readily to others. These practices also serve

to liberate our innate loving capacities of tenderness, compassion, equanimity, and discernment, qualities we can all use more of right now.

I have taken this 4-week module offered by the Institute for Jewish Spirituality, and it continues to enrich both my personal experience of the Shema, and my Mindfulness practice. It is beautiful, and heart-opening. In fact, I am considering signing up for it again- perhaps you will join me!
