

Participation Guidelines for In-Person High Holiday Services
as of 7/27/2021

- Participation in worship services inside the synagogue is limited to **fully-vaccinated** adults and young adults, ages 12 and older, who are more than 2 weeks post-vaccination.
- At this time, the use of a mask is at personal discretion.
- Children between the ages of 2 and 11 years, who are not currently eligible for vaccination, are welcome to attend all worship services and activities wearing a mask.
- Children under 2 years of age are welcome without restriction, as long as the caregiver attending services with them is immunized.
- Sanctuary seating will be set with increased space between rows, allowing for some social distancing.
- We are most willing to set aside a designated seating area for those who wish to sit only among others who are masked. Please contact the Temple office so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
- We will continue to facilitate virtual attendance via livestream **only** for all High Holiday services.
- Youth Services will be held in tents on the Temple property (barring unforeseen weather conditions). Children under the age of 12 will not be required to wear masks while outdoors.
- A Family Service will be held in the back upper parking lot tent, on the morning of the second day of Rosh Hashanah. This service is limited to fully-vaccinated adults and young adults, ages 12 and older, who are more than 2 weeks post-vaccination. Children under 12 years of age, who are not eligible for vaccination, are welcome at this service. Masks are not required for this outdoor service.
- Should Youth Services need to be moved indoors to the school wing, masks will be required for all children and adults.
