

HIGH HOLIDAY COURTESIES

- * Please be mindful to speak quietly when talking with neighbors in or near the sanctuary.
- * Please limit children's food to bottles, sippy cups and dry foods (cereal/cookies etc.). To comply with fire codes and to keep the aisles open at the main services, **please park your strollers in the rear side of the social hall, closest to the kitchen and exit door.** Please choose quiet toys for children to play with, avoiding electronic games, writing, or coloring activities.
- * Our ushers play a key role in maintaining the dignity and smooth flow of the service, please be respectful of these volunteers. During certain portions of the service, they have the sanctuary doors closed. If you are in the sanctuary or social hall and need to leave the service when the doors are closed, please exit at the rear of the social hall.
- * At the conclusion of each service, please return any borrowed tallit, kipot, large print Mahzorim or hearing assistance devices to the table in the foyer.
- * Please avoid strong scents due to allergies and sensitivities of some of our congregants.
- * Please help us create an intentional, friendly and traditional atmosphere without the distractions of smoking, writing, phones, cameras, pagers or any electronic hand-held device on the Temple premises, except in cases of medical needs or emergencies.
